# WARRANDYTE HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM

(The school uniform shop carries all school uniform items)

## BOYS: Years 7 to 10

- Grey tailored slacks or grey tailored shorts
- WHS white shirt\*\*
- Polished black leather school shoes, not boots
- (Term 1 and Term 4) Plain white socks\*
- (Term 2 and Term 3) Plain black socks\*
- Optional Items:
  - Warrandyte High School navy blue woollen jumper with logo (cotton available on order)
  - Warrandyte High School all weather jacket
  - Warrandyte High School tie
  - Warrandyte High School blazer (available on order)
  - Warrandyte High School hat\*\*\*

#### GIRLS: Years 7 to 10

- (Term 1 and Term 4) Warrandyte High School Summer Dress with plain white socks\* and polished black leather T-bar or polished black leather school shoes, not boots
- (Term 2 and Term 3) Warrandyte High School Tartan Skirt with WHS white shirt\*\* and black tights or plain black socks\* and polished black leather T-bar or polished black leather school shoes, not boots.
- Alternatively to the dress or skirt, throughout the year girls may wear plain navy blue tailored slacks or navy blue tailored shorts with WHS white shirt\*\*, plain socks\* (white in Terms 1&4, black in Terms 2&3), and black leather T-bar or polished black leather school shoes, not boots
- Optional items:
  - Warrandyte High School navy blue jumper with logo (cotton available on order)
  - Warrandyte High School all weather jacket
  - Warrandyte High School blazer (available on order)
  - Warrandyte High School tie
  - Warrandyte High School hat\*\*\*

### Sports/PE (Unisex)

- Navy and red polo shirt with Warrandyte High School Logo
- Plain navy blue shorts/tracksuit pants with logo
- Black or navy blue sports briefs
- Plain white sports socks\*
- Sports shoes
- Warrandyte High School all weather jacket
- Hats\*\*\* must be worn for outside events during Terms 1 and 4

## VCE (Years 11 and 12) Same as the Year 7 to 10 uniform specifications with the following variations

- Boys wear navy blue trousers or shorts
- Girls in Term 2 and Term 3 wear a navy blue pleated skirt
- Boys and girls in Year 12 have the option of wearing a VCE jacket (student designed and approved by the Principal each year).

### Notes

- \*Ankle socks are not to be worn as part of the school uniform other than as part of the Sports/PE uniform
- \*\*The WHS white shirt is a white button up dress shirt with a Warrandyte High School logo on the collar
- \*\*\*Students should wear a peaked cap or a plain hat with brim, whenever outside during the warmer months.
  Warrandyte High School hats can be purchased from the school uniform shop. Non WHS caps must be plain blue and without logos. Students are not to wear beanies. Hats are NOT to be worn inside the school buildings
- A two week changeover period between skirts and dresses is allowed at the beginning of Term 2 and Term 4 to allow for variation in weather
- Non-school jackets/coats are not to be worn at school
- If a student has a Sports/PE engagement for the full day they may travel to and from school in their sports/PE uniform
- If a student has sports/PE during period 1 they may travel to school in their sports/PE uniform and change into regular school uniform after period 1
- If a student has sports/PE during period 4 they may travel home from school in their sports/PE uniform
- School bags or back packs are available from the uniform suppliers. Students may use non-school back packs, however, these should be plain in appearance
- · A white tee-shirt worn under the school uniform for extra warmth is optional, no other colour may be worn

# WARRANDYTE HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM

## **GENERAL RULES**

The rules regarding the wearing of uniform apply to students coming to school and going home from school as well as while at school, or involved in school activities.

Please note: For all outside events during Terms 1 and 4, school hats or other plain hats will be required.

- The school colours are navy blue, red and white and may be used for head bands/tying back hair, etc. NO OTHER COLOURS are to be worn (house colours on sports day excepted).
- 2. Students are not to wear items of costume jewellery, items of religious significance or neck chains must be completely covered by the uniform. A maximum of three small sleepers or studs (per ear) can be worn for pierced ears, other earnings are not permitted. Studs or sleepers are not permitted to be worn in any other visible part of the body, including nose, eyebrows, tongue or cheek.
- 3. Wearing of cosmetics will only be permitted if foundation is of a natural skin tone and contains a sunblock ingredient. Nail polish will only be permitted if it is a clear, non-coloured variety.
- 4. Badges worn on jumpers or jackets must be officially sanctioned by the school i.e. SRC, House Captain, etc.
- 5. Students are expected to be neat in appearance at all times. In the interests of personal and public health, students are expected to show high standards of personal hygiene. Part of the policy governing school uniform includes the way it is worn. Skirts are to be of a modest and appropriate length, it is a symbol of our school and something of which to be proud. It is to be worn neatly and the uniform kept clean. It is as important to take a pride in our appearance, just as it is to get to school promptly and to complete work on time.
- 6. Extremes in terms of hairstyles, hair colour and facial hair must be avoided at all times. The Principal/Assistant Principal will exercise final judgement on such matters.
- 7. Students out of uniform **MUST OBTAIN** a Uniform Pass from the Sub-school Office at the beginning of the day BEFORE going to class. Failure to do this will incur a penalty with repeated breeches of the school rules treated very seriously.
- 8. Staff enforce the Uniform Policy with vigilance and students will be given detention either at lunchtime or after school for incorrect uniform. Incorrect items of uniform may be confiscated.
- Failure to bring correct uniform for PE and/or Sport will be treated in the same way as failure to dress correct normal school uniform. Senior School students taking part in inter-school terms will need to dress according to school colours.
